

GOD's Purpose: Peace and life God loves you and wants you to experience peace and life: abundant and eternal.

"we have peace with GOD through our Lord JESUS CHRIST." (Romans 5:1)

"I have come that they may have life in abundance." (John 10:10)



"for GOD so loved the world that he gave his only begotten SON, that whoever believes in him should not perish but have everlasting life." (John 3:16)

Why don't most people have this peace and abundant life that God planned for us to have?

The Problem: Our Separation God created us in his own image to have an abundant life. He did not make us as robots to automatically love and obey him. God gave us a will and a freedom of choice. We chose to disobey God and go our own wilful way. We still make this choice today. This results in separation from God.

"for all have sinned and fall short of the glory of GOD." (Romans 3:23) "for the wages of sin is death, but the gift of GOD is eternal life in CHRIST JESUS, our Lord." (Romans 6:23)

Our attempts to reach GOD People have tried many ways to bridge this gap between themselves and God....

"there is a way that seems right to man, but in the end it leads to death." (Proverbs 14:12) "but your iniquities have separated you from your GOD; your sins have hidden his face from you, so that he will not hear." (Isaiah 59:2)

Our Response: Receive CHRIST We must trust Jesus Christ as Lord and Saviour and receive him by personal invitation.

First Word

Be of Good Cheer

2 Corinthians 4:16-18

16 Therefore we do not lose heart. Even though our outward man is perishing, yet the inward man is being renewed day by day. 17 For our light affliction, which is but for a moment, is working for us a far more exceeding and eternal weight of glory, 18 while we do not look at the things which are seen, but at the things which are not seen. For the things which are seen are temporary, but the things which are not seen are eternal.



The truth is that as Christians we will have challenges, we will have issues, we will be persecuted, we will be marginalised, we will be rejected, we will be overlooked, we will be falsely accused, the list can go on. Yet in all of these things we do not loose heart. These will also pass, that is what Paul is telling us.

In John 16:33 Jesus says:

These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. In the world you will have tribulation; but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

He tells us that "in the world you will have tribulations", It is apparent from Jesus' statement that as Christians we are not immune to tribulations, hardship, disappointments, and trials. However, the good news is in Jesus' next statement - "but be of good cheer, I have overcome the world."

Our trust and confidence should be in Jesus, who has overcome the World, so no matter what the world throws at us, Jesus says I am your peace - These things I have spoken to you, that in Me you may have peace. You don't have to worry, trust Me, and depend on Me.

Even though we are Christians, we have not been promised a stress-free existence, but Jesus has promised us His peace and this we can trust.

In Romans 5:1-4 Paul tells us that Jesus is our peace and goes on to tell

us that because of the peace we have in Christ we can go through tribulations knowing that God is using our tribulations and trials for character formation.

Romans 5:1-4

Therefore, having been justified by faith, [a]we have peace with God through our Lord Jesus Christ, 2 through whom also we have access by faith into this grace in which we stand, and rejoice in hope of the glory of God. 3 And not only that, but we also glory in tribulations, knowing that tribulation produces perseverance; 4 and perseverance, character; and character, hope.

Every Christian with the hope of eternity would have to go through earthly trials that prepares us for eternity with God.

The opening chapter of the book of James tells us to count every trial, every challenge we face as joy. He goes on to tell us that our trials and challenges is creating patience and maturity in us.

James 1:2-4

2 My brethren, count it all joy when you fall into various trials, 3 knowing that the testing of your faith produces patience. 4 But let patience have its perfect work, that you may be perfect and complete, lacking nothing.

The storms of life is part of the training Christians go through whilst on this earth. If we are to obtain the divine power and nature of God, we will have to learn how to handle the storms of life, by looking unto Jesus the author and the finisher of our faith.

The good news is that we do not handle this in our strength, Peter encourages us in his word to the Church, **2 Peter 1:1-4.**

Simon Peter, a bondservant, and apostle of Jesus Christ,

To those who have obtained like precious faith with us by the righteousness of our God and Savior Jesus Christ:

2 Grace and peace be multiplied to you in the knowledge of God and of Jesus our Lord, 3 as His divine power has given to us all things that pertain to life and godliness, through the knowledge of Him who called us by glory and virtue, 4 by which have been given to us exceedingly great and precious promises, that through these you may be partakers of the divine nature, having escaped the corruption that is in the world through lust.

Trials, adversities, challenges, and pressures we face, be it on a daily basis or occasionally are all working in our favour in fulfilling the great and precious promises of God in our lives. That we may become partakers of God's divine power and nature.

So, brethren be of good cheer Jesus has overcome the world and He tells us in **Matthew 28: 20**

I am with you always, even to the end of the age".

God's Waiting Room

The scripture in **Isaiah 49:23** caught my attention the other day during my early morning devotion.

Kings shall be your foster fathers,
And their queens your nursing mothers.
They shall bow down to you with their faces to the earth,
And lick up the dust of your feet.
Then you will know that I am the Lord,

I was drawn to the last line in the verse.

"For they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me."

It is true that no one who waits on the Lord will ever be put to shame! Waiting can be the most frustrating thing a person can do.

During the waiting times, you are oblivious of what is going on at the other end

Waiting can be sometimes annoying because you are looking at the clock and the promised time is slipping by, and you wonder will they ever come.

Can you just imagine when you had to wait for a plumber, an electrician, or a parcel to be delivered?

Waiting for God is completely different, even though it can sometimes

be frustrating too, as you do not know what is going on in the background.

When you look at your situation and you wonder how much more do I have to pray, fast, and give. Everything I have waited for seem to elude me. Is God ever going to show up.

My encouragement however is this, it does not really matter how long you have waited for God, He always shows up on time and at the right time.

At right place and compensates you for your wait.

Then you will know that I am the Lord, For they shall not be ashamed who wait for Me."

I am convinced by scripture that no one who has ever waited on God has ever been put to shame.

Abraham waited 25 years and even laughed at his own situation; his wife Sarah laughed at the thought of ever having a child.

When it looked as though it was all over God showed up.

Isaiah 40:30

Joseph waited for a fulfilment of his God given dream to come to pass.

He waited in a pit.

He waited in the convoy of the Midianites' slave traders.


The Arise Series—Heavenly Vision

As a Christian, we ask ourselves what is my heavenly vision? We may be concerned because we did not have an encounter with God similar to what happened to Paul, or the demon possessed man set free in Matt 5 vs 18-20 as noted in the below scriptures.

Acts 26 vs 15-19 – in this scripture, the apostle Paul testifies to King Agrippa that he has been faithful to the call of God on his life – referred to as the heavenly vision.

In Acts 9 vs 3 -7, Paul encountered Jesus on the road to

You are the light of the world....

Let your light so shine before men, that they may see your good works and glorify your Father in heaven.

Eph 5vs 8-14

For you were once darkness, but now you are light in the Lord.

Walk as children of light*

for the fruit of the Spirit is in all goodness, righteousness, and truth* finding out what is acceptable to the Lord*

And have no fellowship with the unfruitful works of darkness, but rather expose them*.

See then that you walk circumspectly, not as fools but as wise* redeeming the time because the days are evil. *

In Rom 13vs 11-14 we have a number of key factors repeated. God is admonishing us to put on Christ, *put on the armour of light and walk properly, not in strife, lust or envy. In Mark 5 vs 18-20, we have a demon-possessed man who was delivered and set free by Jesus, and he wanted to stay with Jesus but he was told to go and tell others of what God has done for him, which he did excitedly.

Key question to all of us?

- 1. Will I be the light of the world?
- 2. What do I need to and how should I let that light shine?
- 3. How do I put on Jesus?
- 4. What is my heavenly vision, and will I walk in it?

Youth Corner

A few answers include.

- Spending dedicated time with God daily by speaking to Him, learning, and meditating on scripture, singing or speaking psalms of gratitude and thanksgiving, changing our thoughts to think like He does; you can also ask God about what your own personalised heavenly vision is besides being called to be the Light and direct others to Him.
- 2. Being Jesus to others, kind supportive, empathetic, show forth love and understanding, praying for others, sharing the truth that Jesus wants to have a personal walking relationship with each person and leading them to Jesus, even inviting them to church, youth hub, youth cell... the list is endless.

Why not make a commitment today? To be that Light of the World and not hide what God has done for us .. go on, let us start today and do so daily. I am going to, will you join me? let us shine brighter and ask God for the Grace to do so but we need to be intentional. ok..



Bible Book of the Month

THE BOOK OF HOSEA


This month, let's join to read, meditate, study, and explore the book of HOSEA.

The book of Hosea is a Narrative History and Prophetic Oracle. Hosea is the first book in the sections of Minor Prophets. They are called Minor Prophets not because their material is less important or insignificant, but because of the size of the book they wrote was shorter in length. The prophet Hosea wrote it at approximately 715 B.C. It records the events from 753-715 B.C. including the fall of the Northern Kingdom in 722. The key personalities are Hosea, Gomer, and their children.

Its purpose was to illustrate the spiritual adultery of Israel and God's boundless love for His sinful people. Hosea brings God's message to the wicked Northern Kingdom.

During this time, they are active in oppressing the poor in slavery and worshipping idols. God, because of His grace, sent another opportunity for Israel to repent and turn to Him. Shortly thereafter, the Northern Kingdom went into permanent captivity.

- In chapters 1-3, God gives Hosea instructions to marry an unfaithful woman and he obeys. His unfaithful wife Gomer leaves him and finds another man. Hosea is faithful; he finds her, redeems her and brings her back home to him.
- Chapters 4-14 Hosea describes how Israel has been unfaithful to God. God wants Israel to repent and turn from their wickedness. He wants to restore Israel however, they continue to disobey and follow their own ways.
