EXHORTATION

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

1 Samuel 2:26 26 And the child Samuel grew in stature, and in favor both with the Lord and men.

Luke 2:52 52 And Jesus increased in wisdom and stature, and in favor with God and men.

Our theme for the month of July is, "God's Favour". Every

Matthew 6:25-33

25 "Therefore I tell you, do not worry about your life, what you will eat or drink; or about your body, what



you will wear. Is not life more than food, and the body more than clothes? 26 Look at the birds of the air; they do not sow or reap or store away in barns, and yet your heavenly Father feeds them. Are you not much more valuable than they? 27 Can any one of you by worrying add a single hour to your life?

28 "And why do you worry about clothes? See how the flowers of the field grow. They do not labour or spin. 29 Yet I tell you that not even Solomon in all his splendour was dressed like one of these. 30 If that is how God clothes the grass of the field, which is here today and tomorrow is thrown into the fire, will he not much more clothe you—you of little faith? 31 So do not worry, saying, 'What shall we eat?' or 'What shall we drink?' or 'What shall we wear?' 32 For the pagans run after all these things, and your heavenly Father knows that you need them. 33 But seek first his kingdom and his righteousness, and all these things will be given to you as well. 34 Therefore do not worry about tomorrow, for tomorrow will worry about itself. Each day has enough trouble of its own.

It is not everyone who is truly content with life, we are often unsatisfied with many things. There are those who worry about everything, the clothes they wear, where they live, how much money they have, how many friends they have on Facebook, how many people follow them on social media.

The more they have the more they want, they have no sense of satisfaction or contentment. The accumulation of wealth and possessions only fuels a desire for further accumulation, yet there is no satisfaction.

I grew up looking for contentment and satisfaction everywhere, trying to please everyone. Smiled to be accepted, did things so I can be popular but was never

contented, because the more I got the more I wanted. The more I gave the more people wanted. It became very exhausting.

You buy a house, before you know it, you want a bigger one, because your friend or your family member has a bigger and better one. You buy a car and after a few years you want something more prestigious, because your neighbour has something more prestigious. The manufacturers don't help matters either, every year they come out with something new. Many of the manufacturers wet your appetite every year by announcing the latest gadgets and there are those who thrive on having the latest. Some people queue up for days waiting outside stores for the latest gadgets.

Philippians 4:10-13

10 But I rejoiced in the Lord greatly that now at last your care for me has flourished again; though you surely did care, but you lacked opportunity. 11 Not that I speak in regard to need, for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content: 12 I know how to be abased, and I know how to abound. Everywhere and in all things, I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need. 13 I can do all things through Christ who strengthens me.

Have you yet learnt the secret of contentment? How content are you? How content are you with your life?

Paul said," for I have learned in whatever state I am, to be content".

How did Paul the Apostle get to this point in his life. How was it that a man who was one of the best in His field, a champion for Judaism, become so content being a "tent maker" apostle for Christ. What was the secret?

When we look at Paul's early life, we find a man who was studious, zealous and religious. Killing Christians, hoping to please God and win accolades among the Pharisees.

So, what happened?

The secret lies in his encounter with Jesus. Paul's true sufficiency was found in Christ, the One who gives him.

Paul said in his teachings that he had learnt what it means to be at the bottom, what it means to have nothing (TO BE ABASED) and still be filled with joy. Whether there was food on the table or not, whether he had money in his account or not, he had come to learn true sufficiency because his sufficiency was in Christ Jesus.

He had also learnt what it means to have, (TO ABOUND) to be abundantly furnished, and to flourish in life.

"Everywhere and in all things, I have learned both to be full and to be hungry, both to abound and to suffer need".

When Paul says, *"I have learned"*, what he is saying to us is that there was a time when he would have been discontent with life. A time when he would have been upset and angry if nobody acknowledged him. He would have flipped if nobody acknowledged his service, his worth, when he could not handle rejection, suffering, hunger, etc. There was a time when he could not handle failure or success. But now, he can handle anything, not because of his prowess or his own ability but because of Christ Jesus.

Paul having had an encounter with Jesus, had gained and acquired the knowledge of what it means to live a life of contentment, no matter what life threw in his path.

His boast was," *I can do all this through him who gives me strength"* Through Christ Jesus, his Lord.

Can you boldly say the same thing?

Yes, you can. It is Christ who gives us strength through the Holy Spirit to do everything that seemingly looks impossible. We have to learn from Him.

Matthew 11:28-30

28 "Come to me, all you who are weary and burdened, and I will give you rest. 29 Take my yoke upon you and learn from me, for I am gentle and humble in heart, and you will find rest for your souls. 30 For my yoke is easy and my burden is light."

Are you feeling unsatisfied, unappreciated, unloved, the world seems to be treating you badly? Are you isolated, confused, wanting more and more but you keep missing the finishing line? Come to Jesus and learn contentment and satisfaction from Him now.

SUNDAY 10TH JULY— SUNDAY 7TH AUGUST

Introduction (all scriptures are NKJV unless otherwise stated)

Week 1- Commencing Sunday, 10 July

PRAYER POINT- Encounter (& parents, operations and festival workers see additional prayer points for details)

Encountering God is a consistent and continual process throughout a personal relationship with God through Christ Jesus

- For our youth to encounter God/encounter the presence of God - they are predestined for good works.

- For their hearts and minds to be open to the presence of God, to the person of the Holy Spirit and for them to surrender their lives to Him (for the veil to be removed from their hearts and scales from their eyes).

- For them to be drawn to the Lord and their spirits to bear witness with the Holy Spirit

John 6 vs 44 The Father is the One who sent me. No one can come to me unless the Father draws him to me, and I will raise that person up on the last day.

Roms 9 vs 9 that if you confess with your mouth the Lord Jesus and believe in your heart that God has raised Him from the dead, you will be saved. Vs 10 For with the heart one believes unto righteousness, and with the mouth confession is made unto salvation.

Psalm 16vs 11 - You will show me the path of life; In Your presence *is* fullness of joy; At Your right hand *are* pleasures forevermore.

2 Cor 3 vs 14 But their minds were blinded. For until this day the same veil remains unlifted in the reading of the Old Testament, because the *veil* is taken away in Christ. 15 But even to this day, when Moses is read, a veil lies on their heart. 16 Nevertheless when one turns to the Lord, the veil is taken away 17 Now the Lord is the Spirit; and where the Spirit of the Lord *is*, there *is* liberty. 18 But we all, with unveiled face, beholding as in a mirror the glory of the Lord, are being transformed into the same image from glory to glory, just as by the Spirit of the Lord.

Acts 9vs 18 - Immediately there fell from his (Paul's) eyes *something* like scales, and he received his sight at once; and he arose and was baptized.

Matt 22vs 37 - Jesus said to him, "You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart, with all your soul, and with all your mind.' 38 This is the first and great commandment.

John 15 vs 26 But when the Helper comes, whom I shall send to you from the Father, the Spirit of truth who proceeds from the Father, He will testify of Me.

John 16 vs 8 And when He has come, He will convict the world of sin, and of righteousness, and of judgement: 9 of sin, because they do not believe in Me;

Matt 5vs 6: Blessed are those who hunger and thirst for righteousness, For they shall be filled.

Week 2 - Commencing Sunday, 17 July 2022

PRAYER POINT - Spiritual family - unity and becoming family(& parents, operations and festival workers see additional prayer points for details))

- For bonds of godly friendship and family to begin to form among the youth and other believers in their local church and at the festival

- For godly principles of family to be established as their core value and belief system, for their foundation to be embedded in kingdom living

- To support each other (not form cliques) but to, serve each other, assist each other, be kind and thoughtful

Matt 22vs 37 - Jesus said to him, "......39 And the second is like it: 'You shall love your neighbour as yourself.'

John 17vs 20 (NLT) "I am praying not only for these disciples but also for all who will ever believe in me through their message. 21 I pray that they will all be one, just as you and I are one—as you are in me, Father, and I am in you. And may they be in us so that the world will believe you sent me. 22 "I have given them the glory you gave me, so they may be one as we are one. 23 I am in them and you are in me. May they experience such perfect unity that the world will know that you sent me and that you love them as much as you love me. 24 Father, I want these whom you have given me to be with me where I am. Then they can see all the glory you gave me because you loved me even before the world began!

Psalm 133vs 1 - Behold, how good and how pleasant it is for brethren to dwell together in unity

Eph 4vs 16 from whom the whole body, joined and knit together by what every joint supplies, according to the effective working by which every part does its share, causes growth of the body for the edifying of itself in love.

Week 3- Commencing Sunday, 24 July 2022

PRAYER POINT - Fun; Liberty; Rejoicing; Embrace serving (& parents, operations and festival workers see additional prayer points for details))

- The youth will participate in the different events available and be open to trying new things

- For the youth to move outside their comfort zone and try new experiences

- The youth participation to be inclusive and include other people that we don't normally discuss with.

- For the youth to be open to serve one another, be generous and supporting each other and have a posture of service and follow Jesus in serving people

- For the youth to look to outdo one another in honour, service and kindness
- For the youth to embrace the element of giving and show acts of kindness

Phil 4 vs7 - Rejoice in the Lord always. Again I will say, rejoice! 5 Let your gentleness be known to all men. The Lord *is* at hand.

Rom 12 vs 10 be kindly affectionate to one another with brotherly love, in honor giving preference to one another; 11 not lagging in diligence, fervent in spirit, serving the Lord;12 rejoicing in hope, patient in tribulation, continuing steadfastly in prayer; 13 distributing to the needs of the saints, given to hospitality. 14 Bless those who persecute you; bless and do not curse. 15 rejoice with those who rejoice, and weep with those

who weep. 16 Be of the same mind toward one another. Do not set your mind on high things, but associate with the humble. Do not be wise in your own opinion.

John 12 vs 26 If anyone serves Me, let him follow Me; and where I am, there My servant will be also. If anyone serves Me, him my Father will honour.

John 13 vs 14 If I then, your Lord and Teacher, have washed your feet, you also ought to wash one another's feet.

Acts 20:35 I have shown you in every way, by labouring like this, that you must support the weak. And remember the words of the Lord Jesus, that He said, 'It is more blessed to give than to receive.'

1 Tim 4:12 "Let no one despise you for your youth, but set the believers an example in speech, in conduct, in love, in faith, in purity.

Week 4- Commencing Sunday, 31 July 2022

PRAYER POINT - Listening to/perceiving the voice of God/the promptings of the Holy Spirit (& parents, operations and festival workers see additional prayer points)

- For the youth to hear God's voice and direction;

- For the youth to be comfortable with silence and the quietness of their soul to hear God

For the youth to make space for God to speak to them and move away from the noise of social media, thoughts and allow the peace of God to flood their hearts
To listen out for God even in the busyness of the activities

1 Kings 19 vs 11 And he said, Go forth, and stand upon the mount before the LORD. And, behold, the LORD passed by, and a great and strong wind rent the mountains, and brake in pieces the rocks before the LORD; *but* the LORD *was* not in the wind: and after the wind an earthquake; *but* the LORD *was* not in the earthquake:12 And after the earthquake a fire; *but* the LORD *was* not in the fire: and after the fire a still small voice.

John 10:27 - My sheep hear my voice, and I know them, and they follow me:

Isaiah 30:21 - And thine ears shall hear a word behind thee, saying, This is the way, walk ye in it, when ye turn to the right hand, and when ye turn to the left.

James 1:19-27 - Wherefore, my beloved brethren, let every man be swift to hear, slow to speak, slow to wrath

Luke 11:28 - But he said, Yea rather, blessed are they that hear the word of God, and keep it.

Acts 2vs 17a In the last days, God says, I will pour out my Spirit on all people. ... Your young men will see visions,...

Additional Prayer Points

Parents

- For wisdom, patience strength, grace and provision to bring up their children in the way of the Lord; (fruit of the spirit)

- To be godly role models

- For unity in families

Deut 6:6-7 "These words I am commanding you today must be kept in mind, 7 and you must teach them to your children and speak of them as you sit in your house, as you walk along the road, as you lie down, and as you get up."

2 Tim 3:15-16 "You have been taught the holy Scriptures from childhood, and they have given you the wisdom to receive the salvation that comes by trusting in Christ Jesus. 16 All Scripture is inspired by God and is useful to teach us what is true and to make us realize what is wrong in our lives. It corrects us when we are wrong and teaches us to do what is right."

Prov22 vs 6 Train up a child in the way he should go, And when he is old he will not depart from it.




God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.
