

..... EXHORTATION

ABBA FATHER

By Reverend Rowland Henshaw

You see we cannot know the father without a knowledge of Jesus. Jesus said in John 14:7-11. In this scripture Jesus reveals the father to His disciples

7 "If you had known Me, you would have known My Father also; and from now on you know Him and have seen Him." 8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient

8 Philip said to Him, "Lord, show us the Father, and it is sufficient for us." 9 Jesus said to him, "Have I been with you so long, and

yet you have not known Me, Philip? He who has seen Me has seen the Father; so how can you say, 'Show us the Father'? 10 Do you not believe that I am in the Father, and the Father in Me? The words that I speak to you I do not speak on My own authority; but the Father who dwells in Me does the works. 11 Believe Me that I am in the Father and the Father in Me, or else believe Me for the sake of the works themselves.

The key here to knowing the father is knowing Jesus. You cannot separate the relationship of Jesus from that of the father.

In John 14, I realised that the word FATHER or MY FATHER has been used 23 times. Giving us an insight into who the Father is to Jesus & hence our relationship with father.

In the book of Ephesians Paul writes to the Ephesian Church, saying I bow my knees to the father of our Lord Jesus Christ and emphasis the fact that the whole family on this earth is named after Him.

He is the Father from whom all fatherhood is named

Ephesians 3:14-15 says

14 For this reason I bow my knees to the Father of our Lord Jesus Christ, 15 from whom the whole family in heaven and earth is named,

1 Corinthians 8:6

6 yet for us there is one God, the Father, of whom are all things, and we for Him; and one Lord Jesus Christ, through whom are all things, and through whom we live.

Our existence on this earth is because of God the father of our Lord Jesus Christ who created everything through Jesus Christ and still partners with Him in ONENESS.

SO, WHO IS THIS FATHER?

When we look at John 3:16 *It says for God so loved the World that He gave His only begotten son---*So, we can see from John's writing that Jesus is the Son of God. So, who is God? Many have asked this same question and will continue to ask. Yet Romans 1:20 says this

20 For since the creation of the world His invisible attributes are clearly seen, being understood by the things that are made, even His eternal power and Godhead, so that they are without excuse,

To know who the father is we have to go back to the book of beginnings

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth

The book of Genesis is one when looked at with open mind, we will realise that it is not about creation but about the creator. It does not argue or try to prove the existence of God. It declares the very existence of God.

In the beginning God created the heavens and the earth

The opening sequence is not about how the world came to be but about who created the world.

As much as many will want to argue about this...

1. ETERNAL GOD

God was there before creation. He is eternal. We have to therefore believe by faith.

Hebrews 11:6

6 But without faith it is impossible to please Him, for he who comes to God must believe that He is, and that He is a rewarder of those who diligently seek Him.

He who comes to God must believe that exists - there is something about the word *HE IS*.

When Moses asked God that who should he say has sent him.

Exodus 3:13-15

13 Then Moses said to God, "Indeed, when I come to the children of Israel and say to them, 'The God of your fathers has sent me to you,' and they say to me, 'What is His name?' what shall I say to them?" 14 And God said to Moses, "I AM WHO I AM." And He said, "Thus you shall say to the children of Israel, 'I AM has sent me to you.'

What we can see here is that God existed before existence itself.

Jesus said to the Jews "before Abraham was, I am"

2. HE HAS PERSONALITY

He thinks, He feels, He speaks, He loves us, He makes decisions. He is a warrior; He listens to us and response. He is not an it. He is a person; He is a spirit We are created in His image and His likeness.

3. HE IS UNCREATED

He is the uncreated creator. He has always been and will always be. He is the creator.

4. HE IS CREATIVE

God is very creative, His imagination has no equal - There is not a single human being that has the same finger prints, of the 7 billion people on this universe we have all been created in a unique way.

Psalm 139:13-15

For You formed my inward parts; You covered me in my mother's womb. 14 I will praise You, for I am fearfully and wonderfully made; Marvellous are Your works, And that my soul knows very well. 15 My frame was not hidden from You, When I was made in secret, And skilfully wrought in the lowest parts of the earth.

The billions of stars, the planets, the sun, the moon, the trees, the mountains, these are all the handwork of God.

5. GOD IS ORDERLY

Some years ago, as I was reading the bible the Lord began to open my eyes to the orderliness of God. There is nothing that was created that was created out of place, everything God created has order. When we look at the beginning of the book of Genesis, we notice it says there was darkness everywhere. What is interesting is that God did not create man first, but began in verse 3

3 Then God said, "Let there be light"; and there was light. 4 And God saw the light, that it was good; and God divided the light from the darkness. 5 God called the light Day, and the darkness He called Night. So, the evening and the morning were the first day.

Even the distance of the sun from the earth has all been calculated with precision - the Sun is 93 million miles away from the earth for a reason.

6. GOD IS A COMMUNICATOR

The more we look at scripture the more we hear these statements..." God said" "God Spoke to them" and God said where are you Adam

You can never know Him as a father based on your intellect

It has to be an inner personal relationship because you believe in Him. It is a walk of faith. You have to believe in His existence and that He is who He says He is

ABBA FATHER

Paul now makes this fatherly relationship clear to us in the book of Galatians

Galatians 4:6-7

6 And because you are sons, God sent the Spirit of His Son into our hearts, crying out, "Abba, Father!" 7So you are no longer a slave, but a son; and since you are a son, you are also an heir through God....

Romans 8:15-16

15 For you did not receive a spirit of slavery that returns you to fear, but you received the Spirit of sonship, by whom we cry, "Abba! Father!" 16 The Spirit Himself testifies with our spirit that we are God's children.

You cannot know Him as a Father if your mind is clouded by disappointments Fear of failure Fear of the unknown Fear of disappointments

As we develop spiritually in our faith, we will realize the deep, diverse relationships we have with God, our Father.

Abba goes beyond just the word "DADDY" it is the Aramaic word for father depicting the deepest intimacy of paternal relationship with a heavenly father.

Our Father who is heaven

He is our Creator, Saviour, Judge, Lord, King, father and so on. But the most important appellation to Him is Abba Father. As our heavenly father, he knows us completely. So much is His Love that He has a hope and future for us.

TESTIMONY FROM SIS SAMANTHA HOYER

When the Bible says that God knows what we need even before we pray, this is a very real rhetoric in my life.

I remember earlier this year that during an early morning prayer meeting that Pastor Rowland felt impressed for the group who were on the call that morning to pray for me. He said that he felt that we needed to pray for 'wisdom.' After the call on my way to work, I pondered on this prayer and prayed that God would show me where I needed to be wise in my life. Over a period of a few days, God revealed that it concerned my job. For those who are not aware, I am a Headteacher and have been for several years. I have been in education for twenty years starting off



as a Teaching Assistant whilst studying for my degree, and promotion and studying have enabled me to make my way to Headship.

At the time when God had revealed that I needed to be wise about my job, I remember thinking, but I am not unhappy here. I cannot disregard the notion that my journey to work takes me over an hour and twenty minutes each way and that it can be arduous when the traffic is bad to get into work, but I had got used to it and there had been visions for me to expand the SEND Independent School and create a primary phase where I would be leading the three phases – Primary, Secondary and Post-16 – as an Executive Headteacher. This prospect was very attractive to me, and I was prepared to stay the five years that the Managing Director and School Consultant had projected for me.

However, from previous experience I know that God is never wrong, and He never fails. His timing is impeccable even when our watch has stopped or malfunctioned. I therefore started to apply for another Headteacher position, this time for a Headship that would be a lot closer to home. On the first application sent I was surprised that I had been shortlisted for a Head of School position in a SEND School. Two years prior to this, I had sent nearly one hundred applications and was not successful in being shortlisted for interview for any of them. So, this surprise was genuine. I confirmed that I would be attending the interview and asked to view the school. This school tour confirmed that, although now a qualified SENCO and Headteacher, I no longer wanted to lead a SEND school and desired to move back into a mainstream primary school. I therefore retracted my application and was thankful that my Managing Director and other referee had not contacted, so I did not need to discuss my intentions to leave – well not just yet.

Being fully aware that the windows of heaven were open this time for me to move to another Headship, I exercised wisdom. Before I sent another application form, I prayed and asked God for the opportunity to be a Headteacher over a school that is not connected to a Trust or Academy – I was not interested in any synthetic leadership structures which meant that I had no autonomy as a Headteacher and did not manage my own budget. These types of schools – Local Authority schools - are few and far between, but I know my God. I wanted a challenge and to make a difference

in the lives of the children, families, stakeholders and the community.

I remember the end of the month Prayer night in February 2022, where Pastor Rowland was impressed to pray for me again; he said that he did not know why Holy Spirit kept bring me back to him for him to pray for me. This time Pastor Rowland prayed for me as Headteacher that my school would be a success and that many children and families would want to go to it. Obediently I received this prayer, but I could not help thinking that this prayer was prophetic and did not relate to the school I was currently leading. At home in discussion with Arnold, he confirmed the same thing.

I am the kind of leader that thinks outside of the box. I have worked in some challenging Local Authorities and still do. I am not afraid to be a pioneer and make a difference; I would rather be part of the change than to talk about the need for change and do nothing. But having this stance is only achievable clothed with robes of righteousness.

My second application form yielded yet another invite to interview. This again surprised me because this school ticked every box that I had dared to pray for. It is a Local Authority school, unattached to any Trust or Academy, is a growing 3-form entry school in the locality of Bexley, stable staff team, a healthy budget and would provide the leadership challenge I have been looking for.

Some history about my leadership journey: I have already worked in a Local Authority school in Bromley as Deputy Headteacher and Acting Headteacher for five years prior. At this time, I was the only Black and Minority Ethnic (BAME) Senior Leader, but change does not come from thinking about change, but being a part of the change. This Headteacher position would put me in the same position of being the only BAME Headteacher in Bexley LA. But, like David was told, what you have is all you need – go with the grace you have been given. So, this is what I did.

In March 2022, I went to a two-day selection interview for the position of Headteacher. Based on the other candidates in attendance at the selection day, my twenty years' experience seemed minimal as one of the candidates was the Interim Headteacher of the same school and was just applying for the position as a necessary part of the process, and the other candidate was a Director of a Multi Academy Trust. Notwithstanding this, I thrive from the place of an underdog because I know who my God is and who I serve.

Undeterred by the line-up, I completed all the tasks prepared for the day – an assembly with the staff and children, a data task, a series of written tasks – safeguarding, in-tray priorities task and constructing a letter to an aggrieved parent, observing a lesson and providing feedback to the panel and lunch with the staff. After a gruelling day, I was sent home to wait for a phone call to invite me to day two. A couple of hours later I received a phone call and was invited back to the second day.

The location was not at the school but at a church quite a distance from the school. I knew that I had to prepare a presentation, but the title would be given to me when I got to the venue. An hour and half interview – if not longer – would follow my presentation. I arrived at the venue in plenty of time and prayed in my car before going inside. I was

ready and just needed to advocate my ability to lead this well-established school to the governors and Local Authority advisors. The presentation and interview – alt-hough gruelling – went as well as expected. I refused to be afraid of their faces as it was an interviewing panel of seven. I returned home and waited again for the phone call.

This time the phone call came where the Chair of Governors called to say how impressed the panel were throughout the two-day process and that they would be honoured to offer me the Headteacher position of a primary school in Bexley to start in September 2022.

Although this whole process happened over two months ago, in schools the current and the prospective schools must be in agreement as to when the information can be released to both school communities. The students and families at my current school were only informed last week about me leaving, hence the delay in sharing my testimony.

I thank God for paving the way for me to move on to a Headship of a Local Authority School in Bexley and for there to be the challenge that I am looking for to make a difference in the lives of the children, families, all stakeholders and the community. I am looking forward to the challenge ahead as I know that God had placed me at this school for such a time as this.

PRAYER AND FASTING FOR THE MONTH OF JUNE 1ST TO 14TH OF JUNE 2022 THEME: KEEP THE FIRE BURNING

Leviticus 6:12-13

12And the fire on the altar shall be kept burning on it; it shall not be put out. And the priest shall burn wood on it every morning and lay the burnt offering in order on it; and he shall burn on it the fat of the peace offerings. 13A fire shall always be burning on the altar; it shall never go out.

As we enter the 6th month of the year 2022, we want to keep in focus our theme for the year 2022. We want to pray that, as a Church we will continue to keep the fire burning. We want to see God glorified in our lives, in the community and we want to see a revival by fire this year and beyond.


God Loves YOU and wants you to have a relationship with Him through His son Jesus.
